Umpire Clinics

April 9^{th (Monday)} 5 PM – 7 PM **April 15**^{th (Sunday)} 10 AM – 12 PM

Guidelines for Umpiring:

- A parent is required to attend the first portion of the clinic
- ALL coaches are required to attend one clinic to get familiar with the league rules and umpires

You must be 12 years old to umpire:

- 12 years of age can only umpire for coach pitch and machine pitch.
- 13 and up can umpire coach pitch, machine pitch, minor and junior league
- 14 and up can umpire coach pitch, machine pitch, minor, junior, majors and senior league

What do I get paid for umpiring?

- Coach Pitch and Machine Pitch-\$10 per game
- Minor/Major League Baseball and Junior/Senior League Softball \$17 behind the plate and \$12 in the field.

You will get paid cash immediately when you turn in your umpire slips at the end of the day. This will be handled in the concession stand. **Please be considerate**. When games end, the concession stand is usually very busy. They are doing their best and will get to you as soon as they can.

Expectations and Things to Remember

- Show up 10 minutes prior to your scheduled game to ensure you are ready when the game begins
- Be respectful to coaches, parents and players.
- Be firm and confident in your calls.
- Always pick up your score card from the umpire closet, fill out and have each coach sign at the end of the game. Don't forget, this is your paycheck!

• Self-scheduling will be done thru the Jevin system.

NOTE: Once you schedule yourself for a game and are unable to attend, it is **YOUR** responsibility to find a sub. **GYS will not do this for you.** Therefore, if you do not feel you are able to commit, please do not schedule yourself. I will gather a contact list for all umpires and send it to you so it will be easier to try and find a sub.
