



Player & Parent All-Star Commitment Form
2017 Season

Arcadia Little League provides the opportunity for players to participate in Little League sanctioned All-Star Tournaments following the end of the regular season. As a regular season player, your son/daughter is eligible to nominate themselves for this year's All Star teams. Please read, sign, and return this form to your team Manager.

Personal/Family Commitment: Each player must be willing to commit himself/herself completely to the All-Star team and the schedule as set forth by the Manager and tournament officials. The All Star Season will commence no sooner than June 1, 2017. The player is required to commit to the following conditions:

- Player must be available for ALL games for the duration of the team's tournament eligibility.
- Player must participate in a minimum of 75% of all practices in preparation for each specific round of tournament play. Managers may schedule practices during the morning and afternoons in June and July. Attendance does not carry over for practice sessions from round to round.
- Players who are currently committed to other organized baseball activities during the All Star practice sessions may be granted relief from the practice requirement rule depending on the specifics of the circumstances. Please note below (if applicable). The League President will make all final decisions.

Disclosure of any Currently Scheduled Commitments (if any): Please note if there are any currently scheduled commitments during the months of June, July and August 2017 that may prevent the player from participating in team practices. This includes vacation, travel, sports camps, other baseball/softball tournaments, etc.

Nominee and/or All-Star Player: I hereby submit my son's/daughter's name for consideration for Arcadia Little League All-Stars. I will be totally committed to the team, to all team practices, and to tournament play. I understand that if I do not fulfill my obligations and responsibilities to the team, the Manager may use his/her discretion to replace my son or daughter on the team.
