- Girls softball
  - S. Werner **motioned** to allow a select few 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls (that do not turn 13 prior to Jan. 1) that are not playing on any other team and are likeskilled to play on a league team.

- Minor League.
  - Nick is working on setting up a coaching clinic for minors.

  - Numbers are up for Major league this year, so we may need to review how the draft is done with the possibility of adding 3 teams.

Most tournament team coaches would like to see the teams allowed to participate in both the Greenville Scrimmage and the New London Scrimmage, but our policy states that teams are only allowed 1 scrimmage.
