#### Major Revenue Generators

- Concessions 42% of revenue
- League Registration Fees 20% of revenue
- Calendar Raffle 10% of revenue
- Home Tournament Registrations 7% of revenue
- Tournament Player Fees 6% of revenue
- Sponsorship Fees 5% of revenue
- Golf Outing 4% of revenue

#### Major Expenses

- Cost of Sales/Concessions 27% of expenses
- Equipment 11% of expenses
- Tournament Entry Fees 11% of expenses
- Tournament Umpires 7% of expenses
- League Umpires 5% of expenses
- Concession Workers 5% of expenses
