TOURNAMENT RULES / FORMAT

The tournament is June 2-4, 2017 and will be at Greenville Community Park at the corner of Highways 15 & 76 in Greenville, Wisconsin and at Greenville Middle School only if weather delays across Hwy 76 from the Park.

Fee - \$250 per team with no gate fee charged. *Please no carry-ins*.

Number of teams: 8 teams each for 9U & 10U. 16 total teams.

The April 30th date will be used to determine ages. Please provide a birth certificate upon request.

The roster limit is 15 players. Please turn in your official roster prior to your first game or email it in.

Format -

All ages will play 3 pool play games. The top 2 in each pool will advance to Sunday for bracket play. Three game guarantee, weather permitting.

The tournament director reserves the right to change the format or shorten the tournament due to weather.

Tournament Rules – The full set will be emailed to you. We will use the official Little League rule book for all rules not mentioned in our rules. No lead offs allowed until the pitch crosses home plate. No big barrel bats. Must be $2\frac{1}{4}$ in diameter.

Run Limit -12 run lead after 3 innings, 10 run lead after 4 innings, and 8 run lead after 5 innings will end the game.

Time Limit – An 80 minute time limit will be used. Please hurry on and off the field. The California tie-breaker rule will be used in all bracket style games, excluding the championship game. The pool play games will end in a tie if still tied at the time limit. All championship games will be played with normal baseball rules until there is a winner with no time limit, but the run rule will remain in effect.

Pitching limit – 6 innings per day and 9 innings for the tournament.

Line-ups – A traditional 10 batter line-up will be used or you may bat the whole team. If you bat 10, it is *recommended* you play everyone on the roster at least 2 innings and one at-bat in every game. 4 outfielders will be used.

Awards will be given to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place teams.
